



Lulu K Reeves Scholarship Request Procedure

Neighborhood North believes that all children and families should have an equitable safe place to learn, ideate, and play together regardless of race, gender, sexual orientation, status, or learning ability. We know that limited finances can be a barrier for many families and are glad to be able to offer discounted Admission on our Daily Play Passes for Seniors, Veterans, and anyone with an EBT Snap card. These discounts are available for both online and in-person ticket purchases.

Full and partial scholarships towards Neighborhood North Annual Memberships have been made possible by a generous donation from the Outlook Club of Beaver County in honor of Lulu K Reeves.

Eligibility criteria for the Lulu K Reeves Scholarship is as under:

- a) Families seeking full scholarships are eligible to apply for the Reeves Scholarship based on current enrollment in the following government programs: EBT Snap and WIC.
- b) Families seeking partial scholarships are eligible to apply for the Reeves Scholarship by providing a short description of their financial need.
- c) To qualify for this scholarship, families must be residents of Beaver County.

The selection will be at the sole discretion of the Management. The scholarship is valid for one year only. Renewal of the scholarship is allowable each year. No two categories can be clubbed together.

General regulations governing the scholarship policy:

- a) All scholarship decisions are at the discretion of the management and any representation refuting the decision of the management will not be accepted.
- b) Intimation of scholarship will be made in writing signed by museum representative. No oral confirmation should be considered.
- c) Scholarship amount is strictly restricted/calculated only on the membership fee and all other future programming fees may be payable by the family.
